## LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 25 of 2011

### Hydrographic Survey – controlling depth

The least depth over the Bar, (the controlling-depth for the harbour) is 0.9m, i.e. 0.9m above chart-datum. (To find the depth of water over the Bar, subtract 0.9m from the height of the tide at the time in question).

Masters of all vessels navigating at the entrance of the harbour are advised to proceed with caution and must maintain sufficient under keel clearance having taken into account the draft, speed and characteristics of the vessel, and local wave and wind conditions.

The section relevant to the controlling depth advised in Local Notice 024 of 2011 is hereby cancelled.
