



**LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 3 of 2012**

**Repairs to the East Training Wall**

Mariners are advised that repairs to a section of the East Training Wall in position 50° 47'.99 N, 000° 32'.47 W, approximately 200m south of the head of the East Pier, are due to commence on 22 February 2012.

Works will be carried in daylight hours only during periods of suitable LW. Construction equipment will be land-based, and will access the work site across the beach on the east side of the river.

The works involve diving operations within the river. The diver will be protected by a cage, and the cage will be launched and recovered using lifting equipment located on the (east) beach-side of the Training Wall. International Code-Flag 'A' (blue and white) will be exhibited and approaching craft may be contacted by the site supervisor on VHF Chs. 16/71 or by other appropriate means.

Mariners should navigate with caution in the harbour entrance, and keep a good lookout. All craft should keep well clear of the worksite, and be prepared to follow any instructions from the site supervisor.

Expected duration of these works is approximately 5 weeks. A further Notice will be issued upon completion.
