



LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 14 of 2014

Public Health Hazard - Bathing Water in and Around Littlehampton Harbour

ALL RIVER USERS ARE ADVISED that Southern Water have reported a failure to sewerage pumps serving Littlehampton. Until repairs can be made untreated sewage will be discharged at the mouth of the River Arun. Efforts are being made to effect repairs and it is anticipated pumps will be running again by mid afternoon today (Wednesday 27th August).

Members of the public should be aware that the effect on water quality in the River Arun and Bathing Beaches to East and West of Littlehampton represents a public health hazard. **Swimming diving and bathing in the harbour should not be conducted for the next 48 hours.**

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
