

## LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 08 of 2018

# Armed Forces Day Closure to Narrows and Temporary Marks off Littlehampton Harbour

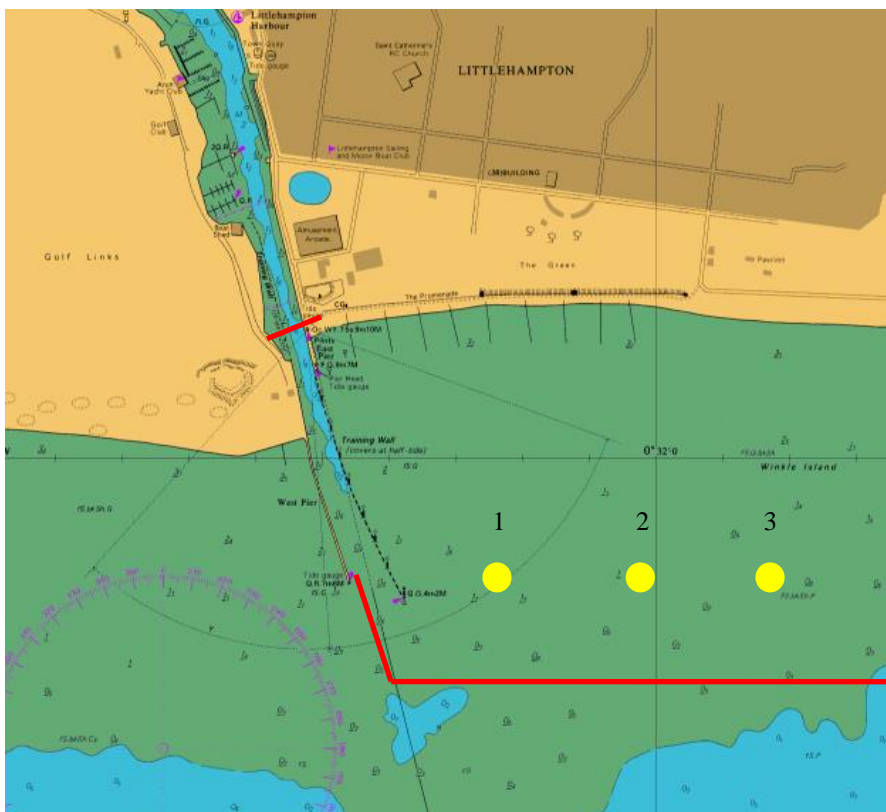
**MARINERS ARE ADVISED** that temporary yellow marker buoys will be placed in the vicinity of East beach for the Littlehampton Armed Forces Day event on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

An aerial display and separate flypast will take place within view of East Beach **between 1240 – 1250 hours (display) and 1535 – 1540 hours (flypast)**. Display aircraft will fly at low heights and carry out aerobatics for display purposes.

Due to the proximity of the display/flypast a maritime safety area has been established which includes the entrance to Littlehampton Harbour. **Unlike previous displays, Littlehampton Harbour Entrance and the Narrows will be closed to all craft for the duration of the display and flypast.** Vessels wishing to view the display should plan to transit the Narrows in advance of the closures of this area which will take **place 5 minutes before planned display/flypast times** and last until completion of the display/flypast.

Mariners are to keep outside of the red boundaries as pictured below: north of Littlehampton Lighthouse and 400m south of the line of buoys when at sea. The Littlehampton Harbour Patrol vessels will be afloat throughout the display/flypast and listening on VHF Ch 71 +16. All vessels are to monitor VHF Ch71 for any instructions from Littlehampton Harbour Patrol.

Cancel this LNm on recovery of the associated temporary marks.
