



LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 04 of 2019

Water Injection Dredging within Harbour Limits

MARINERS SHOULD NOTE that the water injection dredger 'BALDR' and workboat 'HAVIK' will be engaged in dredging within Harbour Limits for a period of 14 tides, commencing on or after 2000 hours on Wednesday 15th May 2019.

Work will be carried out at the Littlehampton Marina, the Tarmac commercial wharves and the Harbour Board moorings at Dukes Wharf, Town Quay and Pier Road. Operations will take place during the night as well as by day. As dredging operations will be continuous throughout the period, mariners should expect to pass the 'HAVIK/BALDR' at any time.

The dredger will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and will be restricted in its ability to manoeuvre during operations. **ALL OTHER CRAFT** should give 'HAVIK/BALDR' (and the areas surrounding) a wide berth, and monitor VHF Channel 71 for any instructions. Mariners are requested to reduce speed as safe navigation permits when passing any vessel engaged in dredging activities.

The 'HAVIK/BALDR' will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 16 and 71 throughout operations, and mariners may also request movement information from the Harbour Office during working hours.

Completion is scheduled for Wednesday 22nd May 2019, but mariners should also note that these timings are subject to amendment as required by weather conditions and are reminded to keep a good look out until these works are completed.

Cancel this Notice on completion of all works on or after 22nd May 2019.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
