

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 10 of 2019

Littlehampton Harbour Waterfront Festival - Sunday 18th August 2019

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the Littlehampton Harbour Waterfront Festival will take place on Sunday 18th August 2019 from 1100-1600.

During this busy day mariners are advised to reduce their speed, at all times maintain a good lookout, keep a listening watch on VHF 71 and to follow any directions given by LHB staff or patrol vessels. A full program is attached. Visiting yachts should be aware that no visitor berths will be available on the Town Quay visitor's pontoon Saturday or Sunday nights due to several large visiting vessels in attendance for the event.

Vessels on Town Quay: Subject to operational availability and weather we hope to host the RNLI all weather lifeboats from Shoreham and Selsey; Sussex Gaff Pilot Cutter MARY WINIFRED; Sussex Inshore Fisheries Conservation Authority (IFCA) patrol boat WATCHFUL; Maritime Volunteer Service launch EAST SUSSEX 1; several Offshore Racing Power Boats and Littlehampton Harbour Workboat ERICA. Arrivals from 1100. Vessels open to visitors once alongside.

Demonstrations between Arun Yacht Club and Red Footbridge:

- **Hovercraft Demonstrations:** 1100 to 1145 then to sea, return for 1415 to 1445
- **Flyboard/Jetski Displays:** 1145 to 1215, 1315 to 1345, 1515 to 1545
- **RNLI Rescue Demonstrations:** 1245 to 1315, 1345-1415 and 1500-1515
- **Power Boat Demonstration:** 1215 to 1245 then to sea, return for 1445 to 1500

All harbour users are invited to participate in this annual event by dressing ship.

Please note: timings may be subject to change at short notice as required by the Harbour Master and participation by visiting vessels is subject to availability and operational tasking.
