ML Tenacity was built by Tyler Boats in 1976 for the Thames Police. She served until the late 90s when she was relocated to Cowes as yard workboat. In 2019 she was extensively re-built in Littlehampton to a TT Boat Design specification to meet the Maritime Coastguard Agency Work Boat Code Second Edition. The re-build included extensive hull stiffening and the installation of a flush deck aft of the wheelhouse.

ML Tenacity is now a fast and rugged work boat suitable for a variety of tasks, including but not limited to personnel transfer, surveys, light towage, private charter, water sampling, film/TV, guard boat duties and training. She is also endorsed as an occasional Littlehampton Pilot Boat. Available for works anywhere along the south coast of the UK
