Casual Pilotage, Conservation and Marine Services Crew

Due to the varying demands on our small team of full time professional mariners, we have fairly regular opportunities for individuals with the appropriate marine qualifications and experience to assist with conservation, pilotage and **marine services charters** on weekdays. These occur across the harbour as well as at sea and making use of the harbour's 10 metre multipurpose vessel ERICA or 7 metre open workboat WINDSONG.

RYA and/or MCA qualifications will be required depending on the task and their role. An ENG1/ML5 medical is required for all of these duties but support is available for this and other qualifications for the right candidates.. A uniform is provided. However, rates are negotiable for out of hours working or where more qualified crew or coxswains are required. Involvement in acts of pilotage (i.e. pilot boat, line handling or footbridge opening for large shipping arrivals/departures or shifts within the harbour) are always paid at £25.10 per act which last anywhere from 15mins (cancellation after muster) to 2.5 hours depending the type of vessel/operation to be undertaken. Due to operational requirements and weather, these shifts are often only finalised at short notice so a high degree of flexibility is required.
