Littlehampton Harbour is a Trust Port governed by an independent board of 11 members. The harbour is a valuable community asset and the board play an important part in shaping its future for current and succeeding generations.

Following 12 years of dedicated service of the previous representative, Littlehampton Harbour Board has a vacancy for the post of Recreational Users' Representative.

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 6(2) of the West Sussex County Council Act 1972, the Board are seeking a suitably qualified candidate who has experience of using ports or harbours recreationally and can, ideally, also bring other skills that will contribute to the effective governance of the harbour's ongoing operations and strategic initiatives.
