

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 06 of 2022

Race Marks off Littlehampton

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the four yellow Special Marks established off Littlehampton by the Arun Yacht Club for yacht racing purposes are now on station year-round rather than seasonal as previously. Going forward, they will only be ashore in pairs for short servicing periods of circa 3 weeks over the winter months.

Mariners are also advised that the licensed positions have been adjusted multiple times in recent years to facilitate shorter and therefore more inclusive courses for amateur crews and/or slower yachts. The previously licensed positions in 2019, 2020 and 2021 are also included in grey above to assist in manual update of charts and chart plotters.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
