

## Harbour Dues – 2022/23

Before launching or entering Littlehampton Harbour, vessels must be registered with the Harbour Master and have paid the correct Harbour Dues. This includes craft visiting from sea or launching from within the harbour and going directly to sea.

Registration can be done online at [www.littlehampton.org.uk/payments](http://www.littlehampton.org.uk/payments), by email on [harbour@littlehampton.org.uk](mailto:harbour@littlehampton.org.uk), by phone on **01903 721215** or in person at the **Harbour Office** on Pier Road. Daily rates for harbour dues (which can be paid online at the above link) from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 will be as follows.

- £13.48 per day for pleasure craft under 11m long
- £16.51 per day for pleasure craft of 11m and over

Vessels moored afloat most often require annual dues as dues are payable for all days afloat, not just days used. For annual harbour dues, an invoice will be generated once the vessel has been registered. If in person or by telephone during normal working hours, this can generally be done immediately if our small team is not otherwise engaged.

Rates for annual harbour dues for pleasure craft (1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023) are:

- £82.07 for vessels under 5m in length (including Jet Skis/PWC with a valid local PWC permit)
- £164.84 for vessels between 5.01m and 8m in length
- £244.70 for vessels between 8.01m and 11m in length
- £326.73 for vessels over 11m in length
- £23.72 sailing dinghies in yacht club compound

Once annual harbour dues are paid, you will then be issued a plaque sticker which must be displayed on the port quarter of your vessel (i.e. on the left-hand side as far back on the vessel as practical).

Longer staying or seasonal visitors may find it cheaper to pay at the Monthly rate rather than Daily if their stay is over a week. Once a stay extends over 2 months, it is cheaper to pay at the above annual rates.
