

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 11 of 2022

Littlehampton Harbour Waterfront Festival Sunday 14th August 2022

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the Littlehampton Harbour Waterfront Festival will take place on Sunday 14th August 2022 from 1000-1700. During this busy day mariners are advised to reduce their speed, at all times maintain a good lookout, keep a listening watch on VHF 71 and to follow any directions given by LHB staff or patrol vessels.

Any prospective visiting yachts should be aware that no visitor berths will be available on the Town Quay visitor's pontoon Saturday or Sunday nights due to several large visiting vessels in attendance for the event.

Subject to operational availability and weather the following will be open to visitors on Town Quay during the day: RNLI Tamar Class Lifeboat from Shoreham, classic gaff-rigged pilot cutter MARY WINIFRED; Sussex Inshore Fisheries Conservation Authority (IFCA) patrol vessel WATCHFUL; Maritime Volunteer Service launch EAST SUSSEX 1; Dunkirk Little Ships NAIAD ERRANT and CARONIA and harbour workboat ERICA.

Various stalls and live music will also be on the River Walk near the Harbour Office. All harbour users are invited to participate in this annual event by dressing ship. The RNLI Lifeboat Station and HM Coastguard Tower will also be open to visitors.
